Dr. David S. Ensor is a Senior Fellow at the Research Triangle Institute. Dr. Ensor has managed and conducted aerosol research in homeland security and environmental protection. He was President of the American Association for Aerosol Research (1988-1990) and is a Founding Editor of *Aerosol Science and Technology*. Dr. Ensor is a Fellow of the Institute of Environmental Sciences and Technology and the American Society for Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE). Dr. Ensor is an Adjunct Professor of Environmental Engineering at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He has a Ph.D. in engineering and an M. S. in chemical engineering from the University of Washington and B.S. in chemical engineering from Washington State University.
